H PRESENTATIONS AND REPORTS

H.1 Presentations

H.1.1 OYAP at the NCDSB — Lauri-Ann Loreto Neal, Vice Principal, O'Gorman High School

**L. Neal shared a presentation on the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) at O'Gorman High School (OHS). The detailed presentation included a description of OYAP, the four categories of skilled trades and the two different levels of participation. She outlined the benefits of being an OYAP apprentice and the requirements to participate. She also reported on numerous events and accomplishments including the end of the semester Career Fair. The presenter proudly shared the substantial number of participants and the immense involvement of community partners, significantly surpassing provincial averages.

The presenter engaged in a question and answer period with trustees who congratulated OHS for their hard work and ongoing commitment to the program.

The meeting also included two guest speakers, the executive director of the Ojibway and Cree Cultural Centre and a residential school survivor.

H.2.4 Special Education Advisory Committee

Trustee Landers reported on the January 25, 2023, meeting. This included information on special incident funding and current requirements, an increase in ESL students and supports for students with autism. She also shared that Superintendent Brumwell shared and updated the committee on the new morning routine for NCDSB's elementary students.
