H.1 Presentations

H.1.1 <u>Mental Health and Well-Being – Update/Priorities</u> – Kim McEntee, Supervisor of Mental Health and Wellness

Superintendent Dunkley introduced guest speaker, Kim McEntee. K. McEntee shared the board's and schools' commitment to mentally healthy schools. She emphasized that the main goal for school mental health is *Promotion and Prevention* and presented priorities specific to this year, which align with provincial key priorities. She presented NCDSB's School Mental Health Action Plan and its five key priorities. Some classroom ready materials/content were displayed for the group to see. No comments or questions. The Chair thanked the presenter.

E. Mills presented her report to the Board of Trustees and highlighted the following:

- Cancellation of exams and the revaluating of culminating activities; and

H.2.9 Business – Personnel Update, Keld Scott, Superintendent of Business

K. Scott reviewed the Personnel Update, which included several new hires (due to new funding), one increase in FTE, one leave of absence and one retirement. Superintendent Brumwell recognized retiring teacher Lynn Duciaume-Quevillon (retiring May 31, 2022). She commended and thanked Lynn for her 30 years of service and dedication to NCDSB schools and French as a second language. On behalf of the Board, she wishes her all the best.

H.2.10 Director of Education - COVID 19 Update, Tricia Weltz

Director Weltz delivered an operational update on the COVID-19 and the return to inperson learning on January 17th. This update included enhanced measures and protocols such as the distribution of non-fit N95 masks for staff, 3-ply cloth masks for students, additional HEPA filters, and rapid antigen kits for students and staff. She also covered the new absence reporting guidelines from the Ministry. She shared an anticipation of staff shortages covering how the board is proactively trying to avoid this situation as well as giving advance notice to families that closures may be unavoidable at times. She welcomed any questions or discussion. Trustees engaged in discussions with the Director on these items with an emphasis on keeping school open. The Director described some strategies that are in place to ensure any classroom or school closures would be a last resort.
